Conversation Starter

1. The story of Hosea is like a movie that should end badly.
 - a. Do you like movies with tension like this story (with broken relationships and hurt)?
 - b. Why do we like tension in movies but not in our lives?

Digging Deeper

1. When Kyle says that each of us is adulterous, do you argue with that in your mind?
 - a. Do you relate more with Hosea (the righteous husband) or with Gomer (the adulterous wife)?
2. Read Hosea 14:1-4. Hosea says to return to God to let him make it right. As Kyle says we need to admit the truth of our wrongs and own them.
 - a. How do we do that?
 - b. Have you ever vocally confessed your sins and wrongs?
 - c. What is that like?
3. In Hosea 14:3, Hosea admits that Assyria would not save God's people.
 - a. How have you turned to other things that save you or give you hope? (money, relationships, power)
 - b. How does God's church do that? (government, buildings, attendance, excitement)
4. Read Hosea 14:4-7. God says that there will be spiritual and physical healing from God when we turn to Him.
 - a. If you have confessed and turned to God, has this proven true?
 - b. Have you seen God's blessings when you gave yourself to Him?
5. Read John 10:10.
 - a. Is that something that you believe?
 - b. Has the church taught that God desires that you and I have abundant, full lives?
 - c. What does the abundant life of God look like?

Gender Breakout

1. Read Hosea 14:9. Life-change starts and ends with God. We can only find wisdom in Him.
 - a. What attribute of God do you need to focus on this week to face the battles in front of you?
